Fri., June 4

Your adventure begins when you board your motorcoach in Indiana for the short trip to Chicago. At O'Hare Field board your non-stop flight for Seattle. You will be met in **Seattle** and transferred to famous *Ivar's Pier 54* for lunch on

the waterfront. After lunch stroll along *Pike Street Market* for some shopping and sightseeing (be sure to catch the fish if someone tosses one to you). This afternoon enjoy a Seattle City sightseeing tour culminating with a trip to the top of the *Space Needle*. Overnight tonight in Seattle. **L**

Sat., June 5

After breakfast transfer to **Vancouver**. Sightseeing will include Stanley Park, Gas Town and other sights on the way to the pier where you will board the beautiful "Diamond Princess". Sail this afternoon. **B**

Sun., June 6

Today you will be cruising through the protected waters of the **Inside Passage**. Nature will unfold before your eyes as you head North. Take some time to explore this beautiful vessel, but you also must keep your eyes peeled for whales that might be nearby.

Mon., June 7

Early this morning you will arrive in **Ketchikan**, your first port of call. Take one of the shore excursions, or walk up picturesque Creek Street to the Totem Heritage Center. This is the Salmon Capital of the World so you might want to schedule time to throw a line in the water. Sail this afternoon.

Tues., June 8

Your entire day will be spent in **Juneau**, the capital of Alaska. Options abound, from taking a tram ride to the top of Mt. Roberts to flight-seeing over the mountains, you will have plenty from which to choose.

Wed., June 9

Skagway is your port for today. One of the highlights is the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad and the amazing stories of the travails of the gold miners. It's also fun to stroll around town and enjoy a snack at the Red Onion Saloon. Sail this evening.

Thurs., June 10

Today will be spent cruising inside **Glacier Bay**. Listen for the crack and roar of the glaciers calving and be sure your camera is ready. The seals lounging on the ice chunks make great pictures too.

Fri., June 11

This is another great opportunity to explore your ship in the morning. Have you tried an exercise class or a spa treatment yet? This afternoon and evening you will be cruising in **College Fjord**. You will be amazed at how your captain moves this huge ship up close to these huge chunks of ice. Try to remember all of the names of these "Ivy League" glaciers.

Sat., June 12

The "Diamond Princess" will arrive in Whittier this morning. After disembarking, your vacation continues as you drive the Seward Highway along the shores of Turnagain Arm to Portage Glacier. At the Begich-Boggs Visitor Center you will see the glaciology exhibits and then enjoy a one hour cruise on Portage Lake with a representative of the US Forest Service. On the way back to Anchorage a stop will be made at Alyeska Resort for lunch and a tram ride to the top of Mt. Alyeska. Return to the Anchorage Airport this evening for your overnight return flight to Chicago.

Sun., June 13

You will arrive at O'Hare Field this morning where your motorcoach will be waiting to return you to Indiana.

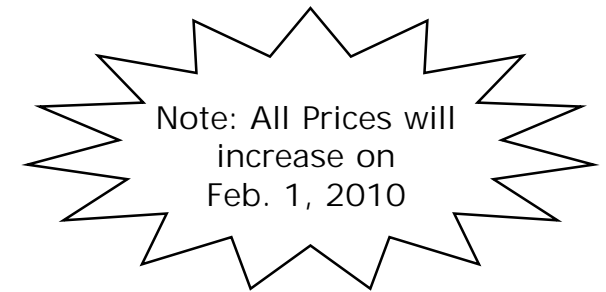
