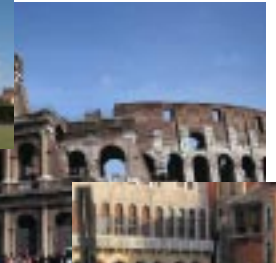

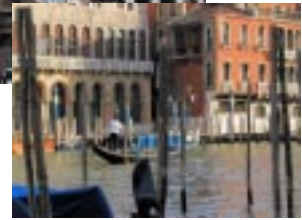

Tuesday, Mar. 15 - Your adventure begins on the short motorcoach ride to Chicago. At O'Hare Field you will board your connecting overnight flights to Europe.

Wednesday, Mar. 16 - Welcome to Venice. Following customs formalities, you will board your private motorcoach and Vaporetto boat for the transfer to your hotel. If your hotel room is not yet available, you will be given a sight-seeing tour of Venice. One could drop names forever here in Venice and still not complete the lists of famous people who have added to the city's luster. The glories that are Venice have attracted Byron, Goethe, Wagner, Shakespeare and now you. Time will be spent walking the sights of Venice: the splendid Piazza San Marco and the incredibly rich Byzantine Basilica San Marco. You'll marvel at the intricate network of elegant squares lined with stately Renaissance villas and palaces. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. D

Thursday, Mar. 17 - Venice/Monterosso If you were not given a sight-seeing tour yesterday, it will be done this morning and then drive to The Cinque Terre (pronounced CHEEN-kweh TEHR-reh) portion of coast of the Italian Riviera, to the west of the city of La Spezia. Cinque Terre or "The Five Lands" is in the province of La Spezia in the Liguria region of Italy comprising five villages: Monterosso al Mare, Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola and Riomaggiore. Your overnight will be in the village of Monterosso. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. B/D

Friday, Mar. 18 - Monterosso Following breakfast your tour manager will assist you in visiting this most beautiful region of Italy and its five villages. The Cinque Terre is a National Park and territory protected by UNESCO. This zone is characterized by the presence of typical steep slopes cultivated with vines thanks to terraces, unique witness of the transformation of the territory carried out by mans hard work. The suggestive kind of coast falling sheer to the sea, with cliffs which are often vertical, alternated with small creeks and enchanting beaches among rocks, with depths rich in fish, make this territory a real natural "work of art". Following your visit of the five villages, return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. B/D

Saturday, Mar. 19 - Monterosso/Pisa/Montecatini This morning your drive will first take you to Pisa to view the "Leaning Tower" and then continue south to the spa town of Montecatini. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. B/D

Sunday, Mar. 20 - Montecatini/Florence/Montecatini This morning you will have a short drive to Florence for a morning sightseeing tour. The flower of the Renaissance bloomed here, and your morning tour includes such supreme works of art as the Piazza della Signoria, Giotto's Bell Tower, Ghiberti's Gate of Paradise, the Cathedral, the Loggia del Lanzi with Cellini's Perseus, the Palazzo

Vecchio, and the Academy where the original, breathtaking "David" of Michelangelo stands. The afternoon is free for you to relax, shop or to continue exploring on your own. High on a hill above Pitti Palace is the Piazza Michelangelo, with a breathtaking view of the city. The Church of San Miniato al Monte is high, but worth the climb for the view of the Arno Valley. Return to Montecatini for dinner and overnight. B/D

Monday, Mar. 21 - Montecatini/Rome Following breakfast you will drive south to Rome with a stop in Assisi. Assisi is built of pink stone and prettily spread in a fan shape on the slopes of Monte Subasio. Its narrow streets are lined with old facades whose flower decked balconies make delightful pictures. Sightseeing of this city where St. Francis lived will include the beautiful St. Francis' Basilica. Continue your drive to Rome for your overnight. Rome is the capital of the Republic of Italy and the center of the Roman Catholic Church. Rising out of both banks of the Tiber, on the slopes of seven hills, it has remained for centuries, a shrine for all those who come to look in awe upon its art and mighty ruins. It is the city of the Pope, of Caesars, of large squares, lovely palaces and fountains wherever you look. Upon arrival you will be transferred to your hotel with the evening free to relax or perhaps begin exploring this romantic city on your own. B

Tuesday, Mar. 22 - Rome Your morning sightseeing tour brings into focus 2,000 years of history. You'll step into the huge pillared recesses of St. Peter's Basilica and view the Piazza del Popolo. Following some free time for lunch, you will be transferred to the Vatican for an afternoon visit of the Vatican Museums. Your evening is then free to explore the little nooks and crannies of Trastevere, to shop the chic bottegas around the Spanish Steps, or to people—watch on the Via Veneto. B

Wednesday, Mar. 23 - Rome/Sorrento Today, your journey will take you to beautiful Sorrento. Sorrento is located on the Amalfi Drive, and stands on a natural terrace above the Bay of Naples and is bounded on the other three sides by steep ravines. Its beauty has been celebrated for centuries. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. B/D

Thursday, Mar. 24 - Sorrento/Pompeii/Sorrento Today you will visit Pompeii, the town which was buried in one of the most disastrous volcanic eruptions in history. It provides first class evidence of the ancient way of life. The ruins of the dead city are deeply moving. Most of the city has now been excavated, the town wall a hewn stone structure according to Greek custom, the streets lined with high pavements and frequently crossed by stepping stones for the use of pedestrians leaving gaps through which chariot wheels could pass. Return to Sorrento for dinner and overnight. B/D

Friday, Mar. 25 - Sorrento/Naples/U.S. Following breakfast, you will be transferred to the Naples airport for your return flights to Chicago. Your motorcoach will be waiting to return you to Indiana. Welcome Home. B
