Thursday, Mar. 3 - Your adventure begins on the short motorcoach ride to Chicago. At O'Hare Field you will board your connecting overnight flights to Greece. Dinner and breakfast will be served on your flight.

Friday, Mar. 4 - Welcome to Athens. Transfer by modern, air-conditioned motorcoach to your hotel. Balance of the afternoon and evening is at leisure for some rest or a walk to familiarize yourself with the immediate area. Tonight enjoy a group dinner at your hotel. D

Saturday, Mar. 5 - Athens/Kalambaka
This morning, after breakfast your tour to Delphi and Meteora will begin. Depart for Delphi via Thebes, Levadia and the picturesque village of Arachova, on the slopes of Mount Parnassus. Arrive in Delphi and visit the Archaeological Site. After the visit, depart for Kalambaka, passing through quaint villages and towns of Central Greece. Arrive in Kalambaka. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. B/D

Sunday, Mar. 6 - Meteora/Athens
Breakfast at your hotel, followed by a visit of Meteora where you will enjoy unique and most impressive scenery. Here, ageless Monasteries containing priceless historical and religious treasures stand between earth and heaven, atop huge rocks. Drive past Trikala, Lamia, Thermopylae (short stop to see across the road the Leonidas Monument). Arrive in Athens early in the evening. Dinner and overnight. B/D

Monday, Mar. 7 - Athens/Mykonos
Breakfast at your Athens hotel. Transfer to the port of Piraeus for embarkation and sail for Mykonos. Afternoon arrival at this cosmopolitan island, known for its whitewashed buildings and lively harbor. Enjoy a refreshment at a harbor side café, with lovely sunset views. Ship sails in the evening. Tuesday, Mar. 8 - Kusadasi, Turkey/Patmos
Arrive this morning in Kusadasi, Turkey, site of Ephesus, where one of the 'Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, the Library of Celsus is located.

Optional visit available to the archeological site of Ephesus, as well as to the House of Virgin Mary. Continue to the island of Patmos, site of the Monastery of St. John the Divine. Optional visit to the Grotto, where St. John received the Revelation as found in the Last Book of the New Testament. Sail in the evening. B/L/D

Wednesday, Mar. 9 - Rhodes "Island of Roses"
Full day on the 'Island of Roses', ancient site of the Colossus of Rhodes. Visit the majestic Acropolis of Lindos (optional) or stroll the narrow streets of the Medieval Old Town, virtually unchanged since the time of the Crusaders. Sail in the evening. B/L/D

Thursday, Mar. 10 - Crete/Santorini
Your cruise vessel will arrive this morning at Heraklion, Crete. A short distance away is the Palace of Knossos, where the oldest European civilization flourished 4,000 years ago (optional visit available). Later today, you will be sailing to the spectacular volcanic island of Santorini and visit the city built on the cliffs overlooking the crater of the underwater volcano. Sail in the evening. B/L/D

Friday, Mar. 11 - Return to Athens
Your cruise ends this morning. Disembark from your cruise vessel and board your motorcoach for a short drive to Athens. The City tour follows, which will include highlights of the glorious history of Athens and concluding with a visit of the Acropolis, where the magnificent temple of the Parthenon reigns over the city skyline.
