

Monday, Jan. 31- Maui Sail at 6:00 PM

Tuesday, Feb. 1- You arrive this morning at Hilo, Hawaii, famous for its volcanos.

Wednesday, Feb. 2- This morning you will arrive on the Kona Coast of the Big Island. Sightseeing is great and you'll be amazed at the black moonscapes and black sand beaches. Sail at 6:00 PM.
