Several shore excursions are available ranging from train rides to the Pacific Coast to aerial tram rides into the rain forest. Later today you will go back out of the Canal to the city of **Cristobal, Panama** where you will spend the evening.

Thursday, Feb. 24- Your port for today is **Limon, Costa Rica**. Some have referred to Costa Rica as a terrarium with incredible flora and fauna, bird and butterfly sanctuaries, and unusual animals like the three toed sloth. Have your camera ready.

Friday, Feb. 25 - One more day at sea.

Saturday, Feb. 26- Ocho Rios, Jamaica is your last stop. There is plenty to do on this island. Of course, you can always shop, but the adventurous will want to climb Dunn's River Falls. On the other hand, if you're a romantic, you might want a relaxing raft trip on the Martha Brae River.
